

spent on their daughter's horse and related competitions, etc.

B. The duration of the marriage is 17 years.

C. The age and physical and emotional conditions of each party: The Husband is 63 years old, and has (and is) experiencing several health-related problems. The Wife is 48 years old and appears to be in good health, physically and emotionally.

D. Both parties are employed, with comparatively similar incomes.

E. This section is not applicable.

F. Both parties contributed to ongoing expenses incurred during the marriage.

G. The parties' income is substantially identical.

H. The Wife shall maintain the present health insurance policy, which allegedly covers the Husband. The Wife shall provide information regarding COBRA benefits to which the Husband may be entitled, including premiums, how it may be instated, and related information, and shall maintain coverage on the Husband for no less than 30 days following her providing such information to the Husband.

6. For the reasons set forth hereinabove, and for other reasons, neither party shall be entitled to receive, nor shall be obligated to pay, any attorney's fees for the other party, and both parties' request for attorney's fees are hereby DENIED.

7. This Court shall retain jurisdiction over the parties and subject matter hereof to enforce the executory provisions of this Final Judgment, and to entertain and adjudicate such other motions as may be appropriate thereto upon proper notice to both parties.
